

## Procedures in case of

## **MISSILE FALL**

Ballistic missiles may fall in less than **10 minutes** after being launched.

When there is a possibility to land on Japanese territory, the government will use the **J-Alert** emergency broadcast system, sending messages on residential transmitters, loudspeakers, and also through emergency e-mails.

- 1 Take refuge quickly;
- 2 Collect accurate and up-to-date information.

Follow the instructions provided by the public agency and always act calmly.

Example of message sent by J-Alert:

"Take refuge. Take refuge. Take shelter in sturdy buildings or underground. There is the possibility of a missile landing. Take refuge immediately."

## After receiving the messages, stay calm and act quickly.

IF YOU ARE OUTSIDE

Take shelter in sturdy buildings or underground.

Underground example: underground commercial areas, subway stations, etc.

IF THERE ARE NO BUILDINGS NEARBY

Hide behind objects or lie on your stomach, protecting your head.

IF YOU ARE INDOORS

Move away from windows or move to a windowless room.



## **IN CASE OF A MISSILE DROPPING NEAR YOUR HOME:**

- **IF YOU ARE IN AN OUTDOOR ENVIRONMENT,** cover your mouth and nose with a handkerchief, move away from the site and take refuge in a well sealed place or stay upwind.
- IF YOU ARE INDOORS, turn off the fan, close the window, seal all cracks and close the place completely.
