The decision that the declaration of the State of Emergency for Oizumi Town which was issued on September 18th would be removed on September 30th was made at the countermeasures headquarters meeting against COVID-19.

**To hate Corona,
but Not to hate People and Not to hurt People**

The State of Emergency was declared on September 18th, because patients of COVID-19 infection increased. After issuing the declaration, the number of new patient fell to the close number which was before the declaration, so I removed the declaration of the State of Emergency. I express my appreciation for all of you. In the future, when one week average of number of patients exceeds 5 persons, or the town judges that it is necessary, there is a possibility that the State of Emergency is declared without notice in order to protect all inhabitants' life. Please understand this and give your cooperation.

Although the declaration was removed, problems of COVID-19 are not resolved. So your own measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19 such as avoiding three C's (Closed Spaces, Crowded Places, Close Contact Setting), washing your hand fingers, wearing a face mask, keeping coughing manner should be continued.

In addition, wrongful discrimination, prejudices, bullying, or etc. related to COVID-19 should not exist. Please never do harassment and slandering in an absolute.

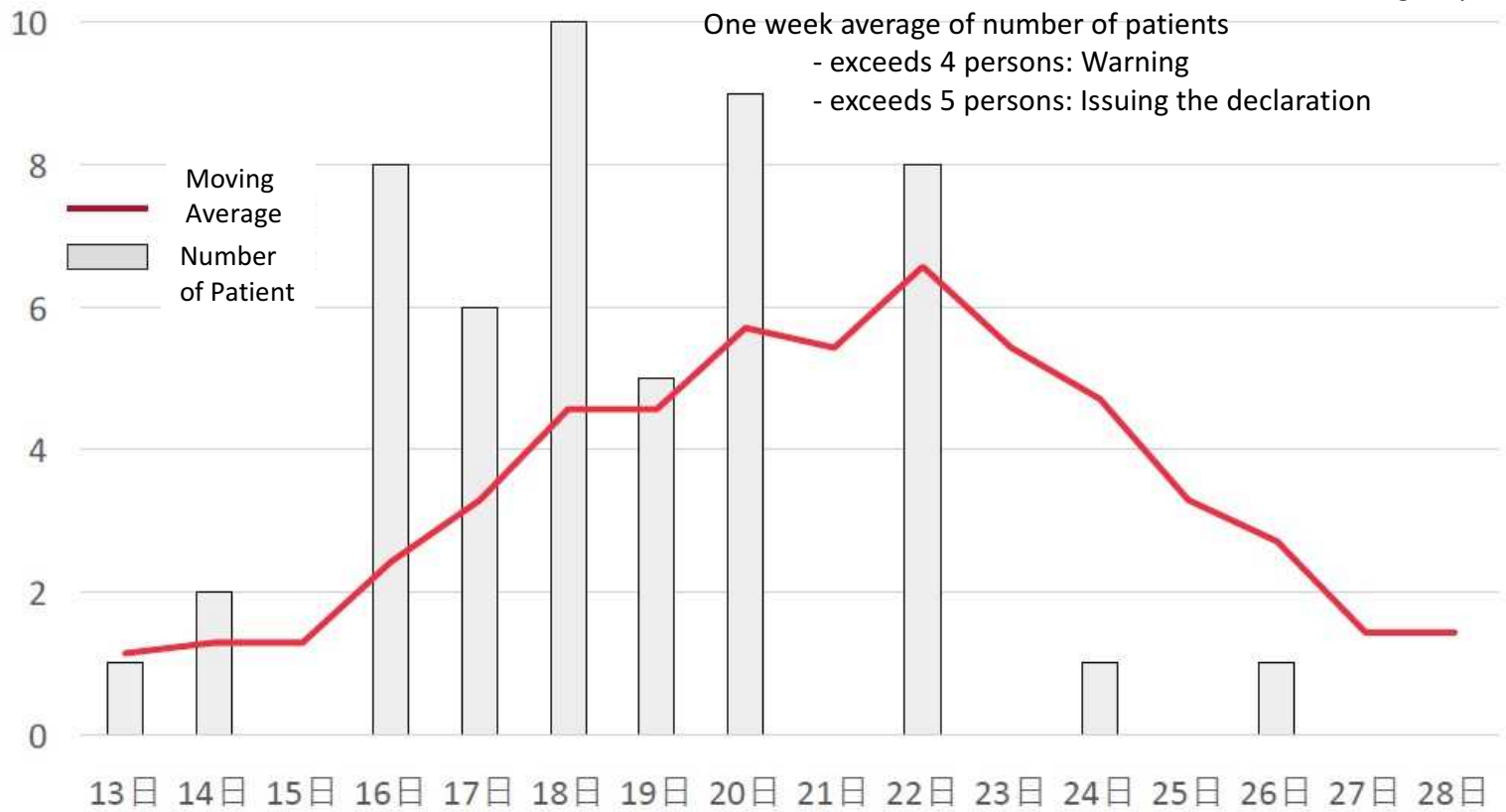

Actions by the town during the declaration of the State of Emergency

- After the town declared the State of Emergency by its own, the town exchanged information with Sano city in Tochigi Prefecture.
- After receiving the announcement by Governor of Gunma Prefecture that patients of foreign nationality increased, the town made the declaration of the State of Emergency known to inhabitants at supermarkets, churches, and business offices where foreign inhabitants gather, and gave them cautions of infection prevention.
- The town explained the situation in the town to children and asked them to do infection prevention at their home. In addition the town asked them to offer information by using SNS or etc.
