Special Cash Payment (Tokubetsu Teigaku Kyufukin) for New-Born Babies [新生児特別定額給付金を給付]

Under being affected by COVID-19 continuously, the town's original special cash payment (Tokubetsu Teigaku Kyufukin) will be granted for new-born babies in order for their healthy rearing and for reducing their guardians' economical burdens.

A notice and an application form will be sent to eligible persons. Please do not forget to apply within the application period.

- Eligible Children: Those who meet the following two conditions.
 - Born from April 28th, 2020 to December 31st, 2020.
 - Who were registered into this town first after their birth, and have been registered continuously until the application day.

Persons who can apply: Those who meet the following two conditions.

• A father or a mother of eligible children

• Who have been registered as a resident in the town continuously until the application day from April 27th, 2020.

- Payment Amount:
- ¥30,000 per eligible child
- Application Method:

Fill out necessary contents in the application form. And put it in the enclosed self-addressed return envelope with required documents, and send it by mail to the Planning Strategy Section (Kikaku-Senryaku-ka) in the town hall.

Deadline of the Application:

The application must be received no later than 17:15 on March 31st, 2021 (Wed.).

- Required Documents:
 - A copy of the applicant's ID such as the residence card (Zairyu Card), the driver's license card, or etc.
 - •A copy of the applicant's bank book that the payment will be transferred to.
- Payment Step:

The application form will be examined in order of receiving. After checking there is no deficiency, the payment will be transferred to the bank account the applicant specifies. If there are unavoidable reasons such as no bank account, the payment will be handed over to the applicant by cash later.

Support Project for Inspection of COVID-19 [新型コロナウイルス感染症検査助成事業]

The town subsidizes a self payment portion of a doctor's consultation fee for persons who were instructed to receive the PCR test or the Antigen test by their doctor or others on or after October 1st.

Eligible Persons:

Registered residents in the town as of the day they received the PCR test or the Antigen test by instruction of their doctor or others. Expenses to be subsidized:

Self payment portion of the doctor's consultation at your doctor's office, at other medical institutions, at Coronavirus Consultation Center, or at Tatebayashi Local Outpatient Inspection Center when receiving the test.

■ Subsidy: Whole sum of the expenses to be subsidized (Up to ¥5,000). One time only per person.

Application Method:

Fill out necessary contents in the application form, and apply it with required documents to the Health Promotion Section (Kenko-Zukuri-ka) directly.

Required Documents:

- Application form to grant the subsidy for the inspection of New Coronavirus Infection provided by Oizumi Town (Oizumi-machi Shingata Coronavirus Kansensho Kensa Jyoseikin Kofu Shinseisho)
- · A copy of the receipt of both the inspection and the consultation fee
- A copy of the detailed statement of both the inspection and the consultation fee

Expanding the Suport Project for Students who Reside Outside of the Town and Extending Its Application Period [「学生(町外在住)支援事業」の対象拡大・申請期間の延長]

As for the support project for students who reside outside of the town, the town has expanded scope of eligible students and extended its application period so that the town can assist more students who reside outside of the town. As the result, graduate students are eligible newly, and the deadline of the application has moved to November 30th (Mon.).

- Eligibles:
 - Students and their guardians who meet the following conditions
 - Guardians: Registered residents in the town from April 1st, 2020 continuously.
 - Students: Students of Junior High Schools, High Schools, Technical Colleges, Vocational Schools, Cram Schools/Preparatory Schools, Junior Colleges, Universities, Colleges, Graduate Schools, and Japanese Laungage Schools
 - who were born from April 2nd, 1990 to April 1st, 2008
 - and also who reside outside of the town (it does not matter the place where they are registered as residents.)
- Amount to Grant: ¥5,000 of the Gift Certificate of Oizumi Stamp Member Stores

Application Method:

Fill out necessary contents in the application form, and apply it with required documents to the Education Control Section (*Kyoiku-Kanri-ka*) directly at the 19th counter on the 3rd floor in the town hall or send them by mail.

- Deadline of Application: November 30th, 2020 (Mon.)
- Required Documents:
 - An evidence to show that the student is in school such as a copy of the student identification card, or a certificate of student registration.
 - An evidence to show that the student is living outside of the town such as a copy of a lease contract of a house, a certificate of residence, a copy of a bill of public utility charges, or so on.
 - X The application form is distributed at the education control section (*Kyoiku-Kanri-ka*), or you can down-load the application form from the web-site of the town.

- Measures for infection prevention such as ventilation and disinfection are being taken at medical institutions or medical examination places.

On-Line Request of a Copy of Residence Certificate (Jyuminhyo) or so on

[住民票の写しなどのインターネット予約]

You can request to issue a copy of reseidence certificate (*Jyuminhyo*) and/or a certificate of registered personal seal (*Inkan Toroku Shomeisho*) with On-Line. When you apply with an designated application form in the web-site of the town, your application procedure at the counter in the town hall becomes simple, and you can get the certificate preferentially. As for application method, please check the web-site of the town (https://www.town.oizumi.gunma.jp).

Objected Certificates:

- A copy of reseidence certificate (Jyuminhyo) of applicant or persons who are living together with applicant.
- · A certificate of registered personal seal (Inkan Toroku Shomeisho) of applicant only
- Precautions:
 - Only applicant can receive the certificate.
 - You can receive the certificate on the next working day of the day you applied when you applied on or before 4:00PM.
 - You can receive the certificate on the working day after the next working day of the day you applied when you applied after 4:00PM.
 - You can request a receving date which is a working day within one week from the day you applied.
 - If you do not bring any identification documents such as Zairyu Card, and Personal Seal Registration Card (Inkan Toroku Sho) for the certificate of registered personal seal (Inkan Toroku Shomeisho), or when there is a difference between the application contents and contents of the certificate, the certificate can't be issued.
 - A copy of reseidence certificate (Jyuminhyo) including My-Number is not applicable on the On-Line request.
