Subsidy for Influenza Vaccination to Children [子どものインフルエンザ予防接種費用の助成]

The expense for the influenza vaccination is subsidizes by the town for children equivalent to the 3rd grade of junior high school

- (15 years old in the 2020 school year) and the 3rd grade of high school (18 years old in the 2020 school year).
- Eligible Children:

Children equivalent to the 3rd grade of junior high school (15 years old in the 2020 school year) and the 3rd grade of high school (18 years old in the 2020 school year) who are registered residents in the town as of a vaccination day.

- Applicable Period: Vaccination from November 1st, 2020 (Sun.) to January 31st, 2021 (Sun.)
- Subsidy: Expense for the vaccination (Up to ¥2,000)
- Applicable Number of Times: One time

Application Method:

Fill out necessary contents into the application form, and apply it with required documents directly to the Health Promotion Division (*Kenko-Zukuri-ka*) directly.

- Deadline of Application: March 31st, 2021 (Wed.)
- Things to bring: A receipt of the vaccination and a seal (Hanko)
- Note: Vaccinations on or before October 31st, 2020 (Sat.) are not applicable.
 - It doesn't matter if the children are enrolled in school.

Recruiting Children of "After-School Child Care" for FY2021 [令和3年度学童保育児童]

The town will recruit children who wish to utilize "after-school child care" from April, 2021. If you wish to utilize it for your children, please apply by the deadline without fail. Please note that you may not be able to utilize it from April, 2021 if you fail to apply by the deadline with no specific reasons.

By the way, children who are already utilizing it at present are required to apply as well. In addition, if you wish to utilize it in the period of long holidays only or in the middle of the school year, please apply at that time.

Eligible Children:

Registered primary school children as a resident in the town as of April 1st, 2021 whose parents or other guardians are always out of their home due to job or other reasons.

Opening Days:

From Monday to Saturday except National Holidays and Year End/New Year Holidays that are closing of children's houses.

- Fee: ¥3,000 = for only one child (¥6,000 in August)
 - ¥1,500 = for the 2nd child, if two children in the same household receive "after-school child care" (¥3,000 in August) (in this case, total ¥4,500 (¥9,000 in August) is charged to the household.)
 - Free = for the 3rd child or more children, if more than 2 children in the same household receive "after-school child care"
 - (Free in August) (in this case, total ¥4,500 (¥9,000 in August) is charged to the household.)
- Application Method:

Fill out necessary contents into the application form, and apply it with required documents directly to a children's house which is in the school district of the school that your children attend.

- Application Period: from December 7th, 2020 (Mon.) to January 14th, 2021 (Thu.)
- except Sundays, National Holidays, and Year End/New Year Holidays that are closing of children's house.
- X An application form will be distributed at each children's house from November 27th, 2020 (Fri.).

Support for Installation Expense of Home Security Camera [家庭用防犯カメラの設置費用を一部補助]

For the purpose of deterring crimes and driving safe and peaceful town, the town subsidizes a part of install expenses for those who installed a home security camera on their house.

Eligible Persons: Those who meet all of following conditions.

- Registered residents in the town who live in the house currently that a home secirity camera was installed.
- Owners of the house or inhabitants who got a consent to install the camera from an owner of the house. (except apartment houses or rent houses.)
- Those who don't have arrears of taxes.

Objects to be subsidized:

- Expenses for installation of the home security camera.
- Expenses for installation of equipments which are functioning together with the home security camera such as a monitor,
- a video record unit, or others. (except PCs or PC related equipments)
- Expenses for displaying installation of the home security camera.
- Subsidy: A half amount of the expense (up to ¥10,000, and 1 pc. per house)

Application Method:

Fill out necessary contents into the application form, and apply it with required documents directly to the Security & Safety Division at the 17th counter on the 2nd floor.

Prepare for a Final Income Tax Returm a little early under COVID-19 Pandemic

The place for a final income tax return is crowded every year.

For the final income tax return of CY2020, you are recommended to file it via the e-Tax with PCs or smartphones at your home or etc. to avoid the risk of infection. You can make the final income tax return without mistake of calculation on the web-site of National Tax Agency. If you are salaried employees or pension recipients, display of the smart phones is easier to input.

For filing the income tax return via the e-Tax or the smart phones , you need to have your "My-Number Card" or "an ID plus a password" issued by tax offices in advance. Please prepare them a little early. If you don't utilize the e-Tax, you can send a printed final tax return by postal mail.

National Fire Prevention Campaign in Autumn [秋の全国火災予防運動]

National Fire Prevention Campaign in Autumn will be carried out for 7 days from November 9th (Mon.) to 15th (Sun.).

- Seven points for preventing a fire and saving your life.
- □ Three Habits:
- Stop smoking in bed absolutely.
- Use stoves at places away from things which are easy to burn.
- Extinguish the fire absolutely when you leave away from a gas stove or etc.
- □ Four Measures:
- Install home fire alarms for prevention of evacuation delay.
- Use fireproof material goods for prevention of the fire from bedclothes, clothes, or curtains.
- Install home fire extinguishers so that you can put out the fire while it is small.
- Establish cooperation systems by neighbours to protect elderlies and disables.

Point of Campaign:

By the fire service law, installation of the home fire alarm is required for every house. If you do not install, please do so as soon as possible for protecting life of you and you family. If you already installed, please check periodically if it works. 4
