

### Information for those who have not completed COVID-19 Vaccination

[新型コロナワクチンの初回接種について]

### **Delivery of 3rd COVID-19 Vaccination Coupon** [3回目の新型コロナワクチン接種券の発送について]

The additional booster vaccine (3rd dose) against COVID-19 is scheduled to be administered approximately 8 months or more after the completion of the 2nd dose. Therefore, vaccination coupons for the additional vaccinations, which consists of a printed coupon and preliminary examination form (Yoshin-Hyo), are scheduled to be sent out approximately 7 months after the month in which the 2nd vaccination was completed. ### Extraordinary Special Benefits for Child-Rearing Households [子育て世帯への臨時特別給付金]

As a livelihood support program, benefits will be provided for households who are rearing a child between the ages of 0 and 18 years. Those who were able to receive the "Jido-Teate (Child Allowance)" for September 2021 will receive a notice to that effect by mid-December. For other people who meet the requirements for the benefits, the application form will be sent out after late December, and the application will be accepted at Children Affairs Division (Kodomo-ka) from mid-January 2022 (Scheduled from Jan./12). Eligible Children:

- (1) Children who are eligible for the "Jido-Teate (Child Allowance)" for September 2021
  - $\rightarrow$  No application is required. Payment is scheduled for late December.
- 2 Children who were born between Apr./2/'03 and Apr./1/'06 and are being reared by their guardians
  - (The guardian's income in 2020 (the highest income of the guardians) must be less than the amount eligible for the "Jido -Teate (Child Allowance)".
- ③ Children who were born between Oct./1/'21 and Mar./31/'22 and are eligible for the "Jido-Teate (Child Allowance)"  $\rightarrow$  If you meet conditions (2) or (3), you need to apply. The timing of payment varies depending on the time of application.
- X Please note that those who moved into the town on or after Oct./1/'21 will receive a notice from the municipality that paid the "Jido-Teate" for September. Incidentally, those who receive the "Tokurei-Kyufu (Special Benefit) are not eligible.
- Payment: ¥50,000 per eligible child (Only once)
- Benefit Payment Account: The benefit will be transferred to the bank account where the "Jido-Teate" was paid in October 2021. If you have cancelled the bank account, please go through the procedure to change your account.

## Applications for New School Enrollment of Foreign Children [新入学外国籍児童の就学申請受付]

The town will accept applications for school enrollment from foreign children who wish to enroll in primary schools in the town newly from April 2022. A notice will be mailed to the guardians of applicable children, so please follow the procedures.

- Application Period: 8:30 11:30 & 13:00 17:00 on January 11th, 2022(Tue.) January 14th, 2022(Fri.)
- Location: Educational Administration Division (Kyoiku-Kanri-ka) at the 21st counter on the 3rd floor
- Eligible Children: Children of foreign nationalities who were born from April 2nd, 2015 to April 1st, 2016

### Outfit allowance (Shitakukin) for Children of Single-Mother Families and Single-Father Families to Prepare for Entering Primary or Junior High School [母子·父子家庭の児童入学·進学支度金を支給します]

The town will provide an outfit allowance for children of single-mother families and single-father families to prepare for entering primary or junior high school in April 2022. For families planning to enter senior high school, applications are scheduled to be accepted in April 2022.

#### Eligibility:

Those who have become single-mother or single-father families due to bereavement, divorce or etc., and those who are rearing children without parents, and also who meet all of the following conditions are eligible.

- who live in the town, and are rearing a child and living together with the child.
- who have not been taxed on their income for 2020.
- who are not receiving public assistance.
- Payment:
  - For primary school: ¥10,000
  - For junior high school: ¥15,000
- How to Apply:

Fill out necessary information in the application form, and apply it with required documents directly to the Children Affairs Division (Kodomo-ka) at the 23rd counter on the 3rd floor.

Application Period:

January 17th, 2022(Mon.) - January 31st, 2022 (Mon.) except Saturdays and Sundays.

X If your child plans to enter a school outside of town, please let us know in advance.

### Provision of Fund for School Enrollment Readiness [新入学準備費の支給]

The town will provide a readiness fund for families whose children are scheduled to enter primary or junior high school newly in April 2022 and who have financial difficulties in attending school.

- Eligibility: Those who meet all of the following conditions are eligible.
  - Living in the town as of February 1st, 2022.
  - Scheduled to enter primary school or junior high school newly in April, 2022.
  - Meeting the criteria for "Jun-You- Hogo (Semi-protection required)" under
  - the "Reiwa 3 Nendo Shugaku Enjo Seido (School Attendance Support System in FY2021)".
- Payment:
  - For primary school student: ¥51,060
  - For junior high school student: ¥60,000
- How to Apply:

Fill out necessary information in the application form, and apply it with required documents directly to the following location.

- For primary school: The primary school that your child plans to enter.
- For junior high school: The primary school that your child attends currently.
- Application Period: January 6th, 2022(Thu.) January 28th, 2022 (Fri.)
- Payment Date: February 18th, 2022 (Fri.) <Plan>
- X An application form is available at the Educational Administration Division (Kyoiku-Kanri-ka) at the 21st counter on the 3rd floor, primary and junior high schools in the town. In addition you can down-load it from the website of the town. ### Points to Keep in Mind when Owning a Dog or Cat [犬·猫の飼い方·相談について]

Complaints about droppings and barks of dogs and cats are increasing recently. If you keep dogs and/or cats, please take following actions for not to bother the neighbors.

- How to own a dog
  - You are required by law to register your dog (once in its lifetime) and to have your dog vaccinated against rabies (Once a year).
  - You are required by law to keep your dog on a leash, so be sure to follow it.
  - To prevent your dog from barking in vain, take your dog for a walk to relieve stress.
  - There have been complaints about people leaving their dog's droppings without cleaning them up while walking. Please prepare a bag and be sure to take the droppings home.
  - Puppies born unwanted are often abandoned, leading to an increase in stray dogs. Consider spaying or neutering.
- How to own a cat
  - Cats are not obligated to be kept on a leash or registered like dogs, but that does not mean you can keep them any way you want.
  - Kittens born unwanted are often abandoned, leading to an increase in stray cats. Consider spaying or neutering.
  - Put a collar or stray plate on your cat in case it gets lost, and keep your cat indoors as much as possible.
  - Set up a litter box in your house and litter train your cat.
  - Never take care of cats (animals) just for the sake of feeding them.

#### If you feed stray cats in parks, etc., as the owner of that cat, take proper care of it at home and keep it in a responsible manner. Consultation Counter for Dogs and Cats:



## Notice about Trash Collection during the Year-End and New Year Holidays

Household trash will be collected as described in the garbage collection calendar during the year-end and new year holidays. Please understand that collection time may be delayed due to congestion of the trash disposal facilities. In addition, please <u>do NOT put trash out after collection or on non-collection days.</u>



The area where burnable trash is usually collected on Monday and Thursday  $\Rightarrow$  December 30th (Thu.) The area where burnable trash is usually collected on Tuesday and Friday  $\Rightarrow$  December 31st (Fri.)

The period not to collect non-burnable & recyclable trash:  $\Rightarrow$  December 27th (Mon.) - 31st (Fri.)

### << Year-End Special Operation of the Trash Disposal Facilities>>

The Trash Disposal Facilities will accept self-carrying of <u>household trash</u> during the year-end. Since the year-end is very crowded every year, so please bring your household trash on any household trash acceptance day other than the year-end to avoid congestion. In addition, please note that *Oizumi-machi Hoka Ni-cho Cleaning "Seiso" Center* only accepts over-sized household trash (60cm or longer size) such as sofas, mattresses, chests of drawers, or etc. after April 2021.
