Renewal of Welfare Medical Expense Beneficiary Certificate [福祉医療費受給資格者証の更新]

The "Fukushi Iryo-hi Jyukyu Shikakusha Sho (Welfare Medical Expense Beneficiary Certificate)" for children who were born from April 2nd, 2015 to April 1st, 2016 will be renewed. As a new certificate will be mailed to each eligible child, please dispose of the expired certificate in a way that does not reveal any personal information, or return it to the National Health Insurance Division (Kokumin-Kenko-Hoken-ka) at the 2nd counter on the 1st floor of the town hall. Please note that children in single-mother families or single-father families who are eligible for the benefit are not eligible for this renewal, even if they are of the eligible age.

◆ Expiration Date of the current welfare medical expense beneficiary certificate : March 31st, 2022 (Thu.) [Requests]

The "Fukushi Iryo Seido (Welfare Medical System)" is to subsidize the self-payment portion of medical expenses of eligible children when they receive insured medical treatment at medical institutions. If you are eligible to use the "Kohi Futan Iryo Seido (Publicly Funded Health Care Systems)" other than the Welfare Medical System, those systems will be applied preferentially. In order to ensure the stable operation of the Welfare Medical System, we ask for your understanding and cooperation in using it conjunction with other Publicly Funded Health Care Systems.

Distribution of FY2022 Garbage Collection Calendar [令和4年度ごみ収集カレンダーを配布しています]

The Garbage Collection Calendar shows the days when trash can be taken out, how to sort it, and examples of not being able to dispose of trash at trash disposal sites (station). In addition, you can also check the garbage collection calendar with "*Gomi Bunbetsu Apuri* (Trash Separation App)". It is equipped with a function that prevents you from forgetting to put out the trash and allows you to easily check various information. This app is free, so please install it if you have a smartphone or tablet device.

When disposing of trash, please check the Garbage Collection Calendar or app and follow the rules. If you do not know where your trash disposal site is, please ask your community leader (*Jichikai-cho*) or life environmental committee member (*Seikatsu-Kankyo-lin*). For information on how to dispose of trash that is not listed on the Garbage Collection Calendar, please ask the Environmental Development Division (*Kankyo-Seibi-ka*).


Application for National Pension Contribution Special Payment System for Students

[国民年金保険料の学生納付特例の申請]

All people who are registered to reside in Japan must be covered by the National Pension System when they become 20 years old, and must pay contribution. Upon application, however, there is the "*Gakusei Nofu Tokurei* (Special Payment System for students)" to defer the payment of insurance premiums while in school. Students with incomes below a certain level are eligible. The application for the fiscal year 2022 (from April, 2022 to March, 2023) will start to accept from April 1st (Fri.).

- Required Documents for Application:
 - Applicant's Nenkin Techo (Pension Book) or the Kiso Nenkinbango Tsuchisho (Notification of the Pension Number)
 - Documents to show that the applicant is a student (Student Identification Card, Certificate of Enrollment, or etc.)
- ** Please note that, if there is no expiration date on the student ID card, the application may not be approved. In that case, as the certificate of enrollment may be required, please inquire in advance.

Subsidy for Purchase of Bicycle Helmets [自転車用ヘルメット購入費を補助しています]

By revision of the Gunma Traffic Safety Ordinance, wearing a bicycle helmet is obligation to make efforts from April 2021. If you are a 3rd grade of junior high school student, please add a bicycle helmet to your high school preparation list, and get ready for high school life starting in April.

The town subsidizes part of the cost of purchasing bicycle helmets. However, this program will end on March 31st (Thu.), so please apply as soon as possible.

■ Eligible Persons:

Parents or Guardians of "High school students and others" living in the town *\times" High school students and others"

"High school students and others" refers to persons who correspond to the following (1) or (2).

- (1) Those who will reach the age of 15 to 18 in the fiscal year of application.
 - (The generation between the 3rd grade of junior high school and the 3rd grade of high school.) X It does not matter if they are enrolled in school or not.
- (2) Those who will reach the age of 19 in the fiscal year of application and have been enrolled in the following schools.
 - 1 High schools 2 Second semester of Secondary schools
 - ③ Technical colleges (except the 4th grade or higher) ④ High schools for special needs
 - ⑤ Advanced course at Specialized training colleges ⑥ High school program at foreigners' schools
- Applicable Expense:

The cost of a new bicycle helmet purchased between October 20th, 2020 and March 31st, 2022 (Only one time per person of "High school students and others")

■ Subsidy:

Up to ¥2,000 of the "Oizumi Stamp Kameiten Kyotsuken (Common Merchant Tickets of Oizumi Stamp Participating Stores)".

 \times If the purchasing cost of the helmet is less than $\pm 2,000$, the amount of the ticket will be rounded to the nearest ± 500 . (ex.; If the cost is $\pm 1,500 \sim \pm 1,999$, $\pm 1,500$ of the ticket will be issued.)

How to Apply:

Fill out required information in the application form, and submit it to the Security & Safety Division (*Anzen-Anshin-ka*) directly (at the 19th counter on the 2nd floor of the town hall) along with the required documents.



Notice of Termination of Handling of Public Money Payments Slips at Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation Counters [三井住友銀行窓口で納付書支払いができなくなります]

The handling of payment slips for town taxes and other public money payment (no charge) at SMBC (Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation) counters will end on March 31st, 2022 (Thu.). Account transfers can be used as usual.

The Age of Adulthood will be Lowered to 18 on April 1st, 2022.

[令和4年4月から成人年齢が引き下げ!18歳から大人]

Due to an amendment to the Civil Code, the age of adulthood will be lowered from 20 to 18 years old on April 1st, 2022. Depending on your date of birth, the date and age at which you become an adult differs, so please check Table-1 on the right. Also, please refer to Table-2, which shows what you can do and cannot do at each age.

~ Beware of Contract Trouble ~

At the age of 18, you will be able to take out a loan or get a credit card without parental consent to pay for the products you have contracted, and you will be able to contract for expensive products. On the other hand, from the age of 18, protection by the "Right of revocation for minors" is no longer available, so it is important to understand how contracts and payment methods work, to check the contents of the contract carefully, and to do so within the scope of your own ability to pay.

What is the "Right of revocation for minors"?

In principle, parental consent is required for minors to sign a contract. The "Right of revocation for minors" is a legal right to revoke a contract made by a minor without parental consent, except in certain cases, and is used to resolve contractual problems for minors. With the lowering of the age of adulthood in April 2022, the "Right of revocation for minors" will no longer be available from the age of 18.

Be aware of these troubles!

Malicious companies target young people who are just coming of age and lack knowledge and social experience about contracts.

- Troubles about Subscription:
 After the trail product, I received an expensive invoice for a product I did not order.
- Cosmetic Medicine:
 - After the cosmetic surgery, the swelling on my face did not go down and I had trouble living.
- Money-making Idea:

I was solicited by an acquaintance to pay for an information product with an expensive loan. I want to cancel the contract.

Nicknames of Public Facilities [各施設のネーミングライツパートナーが決まりました]

Oizumi Town has been seeking naming rights partners to improve the attractiveness and services of the town's facilities, and some of them have now been selected. Naming rights refers to the right to give a facility a nickname. By paying a naming rights fee and giving a facility a nickname, such as the name of a company or a product, a publicity effect can be obtained. The naming rights fee will be used for the operation and maintenance of the facility.

This time, the following nicknames have been decided for the "Bunka-Mura", "Town's Baseball Ground" and "Izumi Soccer Ground". The naming rights period is from April 1st, 2022 to March 31st, 2027, and the nickname will be used to describe the facility name during the contract period.

Change in Application Procedure at Resident Affairs Division Counter [4月1日(金)開始!「書かない窓口」]

From April 1st, 2022 (Fri.), various application forms such as a Copy of *Jumin-hyo* (Certificate of Residence), *Inkan-Toroku-Shomeisho* (Seal Registration Certificate), *Jyusho-Ido-Tetsuzuki* (Resident Transfer Notification), etc. will no longer be required.
