#### Child Allowance or Special Benefit System has been partially changed from April 2022. -[児童手当·特例給付の現況届が原則不要になります]

1. Those who receive the child allowance (Jido-Teate) or the special benefit (Tokurei-Kyufu) are not required to submit the current status report (Genkyo-Todoke) from April 2022 in principle. Your current status of child rearing and income as of June 1st will be checked based on your Basic Resident Registration every year. However, those who fall under any of the following  $1^{5}$  are required to submit the current status report (Genkyo-Todoke). Since the current status report (Genkyo-Todoke) will be sent to the eligible recipients from late May, please submit the current status report (*Genkyo-Todoke*) from June 1st onwards. If you fall under any of the following  $1^{\infty}$  and have not received the current status report (Genkyo-Todoke), please contact Children Affaires Division.

- < Those who are required to submit the current status report (Genkyo-Todoke) >
- ① Those whoes address on their Resident's card is not in Oizimi-machi due to violence from their spouse, etc.
- 2 Those who have thier child eligible for payment requirements, and the child does not have family register or resident card.
- ③ Those who are in the midst of a divorce and live separately from their spouse
- (4) Corporate guardian of a minor, foster parent or person in charge of foster home .
- (5) Other than the above, those who have received notification of the submission from Oizumi Town Hall
- 2. Upper income limit has been set and it will be applicable from October, 2022. Please note that the child allowance will not be paid if the income of the person raising child is the upper income limit or more. If your income falls below the upper income limit after your children's allowance is no longer paid, submission of a new application is required.
- \*If the income of the person raising child is less than the Income limit, the child allowance will be paid. If the income is the income limit or more and less than the upper income limit, the special benefit (5,000 yen per child per month) shall be paid. For details of the income limit, please contact the Children Affairs Division (Kodomo-ka) as below.
- X By examining your income with your current status report, the child allowance or the special benefit will be supplied. For details, please contact the Children Affairs Division (Kodomo-ka) at 20276-63-3111(ext. 352).

#### **Obey the Trash Collecting Rules** [ごみ出しルールの徹底をお願いします]

Garbage stations in your community are maintained by cooperation of all of you. Please check again the trash collecting calendar and obey the rules so that everybody can use garbage stations in clean and comfortable conditions continuously.

#### Basic Rules of putting trash out

- Separate "Burnable Trash", "Non-Burnable Trash" and "Recyclable Trash".
- Check the day when trash is collected with the trash collecting calendar,
- and put trash out at designated garbage station before 8:30 in the morning on the trash collecting day.
- Pack burnable trash or non-burnable trash into transparent or translucent trash bags.

#### Caution

- Do NOT mix up non-burnable trash such as metal objects, glass, aluminum/steal cans (recyclable), glass bottles (recyclable), etc. with burnable trash.
- Separate "Other Papers" such as wrapping paper, brochures, etc., and "Other Plastics" that a plastic mark is put on, as recyclable trash.
- Drain off water of kitchen garbage, put it in bags and close their mouth properly in order to avoid bad smell.
- Do NOT put trash out on the day which is not designated trash collecting day in order to avoid that crows and/or cats scatter trash, or to avoid an incendiary fire.



The town will subsidize part of the expense of adult's vaccinations. Subsidy will be granted only once per each vaccination.

#### [Vaccination against Rubella]

#### Eligible Person:

Married couples who wish to become pregnant or the husbands of pregnant women, and who are registered as residents of the town on the day of vaccination. Marital status is not required, but those who have had rubella, those who have been vaccinated against rubella twice or more, and those who are pregnant or suspect pregnancy are excluded.

Amount of Subsidy: Rubella Vaccine alone: up to ¥3,000 Measles Rubella Combined Vaccine: up to ¥5,000

#### [Vaccination against Pneumococcus for Elderly Persons]

Eligible Person:

Those who are 75 years old and older, are registered as residents of the town on the day of vaccination, and have never received vaccination against Pneumococcus in the past.

Amount of Subsidy: up to ¥2,000

#### Subsidy for the expense of re-vaccination for special reasons [特別の理由による予防接種の再接種費用の助成]

The town will subsidize the expense of vaccinations for those who have undergone bone marrow transplantation and need to be re-vaccinated with routine vaccinations after the transplantation surgery.

- Eligible Person: Those who meet all of the following conditions.
  - Persons under 20 years old who have been diagnosed by a doctor as needing to be re-vaccinated, because the preventive effect of a previous vaccination cannot be expected due to bone marrow transplantation surgery.
  - Those who are registered as residents of the town on the day of re-vaccination.
- Eligible Vaccination:
  - Children's vaccinations that have already been given as routine vaccinations, but have been judged to need to be revaccinated. However, BCG is limited to children under 4 years old, Children's Pneumococcus is limited to children under 6 years old, Hib is limited to children under 10 years old, and 4 Types Mixed is limited to children under 15 years old.
- Amount of Subsidy:

Expense you paid to a medical institution as a re-vaccination cost.

Please be sure to come to the Health Promotion Division (Kenko-Zukuri-ka) with Maternal and Child Health Handbook (Boshi-Techo) before receiving re-vaccinations.
