Notice of Cancer Screening [がん検診を受けましょう]

Notification of various medical checkups including examination labels were posted to those who are 40 years old or older in mid-May of this year. Please check the contents of the medical checkups and how to take them, then receive the medical checkups. If you have moved to Oizumi Town after April 2022, or if you have not received the notice and would like to have a cancer screening, please contact the Health Promotion Division (Kenko-Zukuri-ka).

How to Apply:

Please apply to the Health Promotion Division (*Kenko-Zukuri-ka*) directly, by phone, or via the website of Oizumi-Town. * Gastric Cancer Screening (Endoscopic Examination) shall be applied directly at the Health Promotion Division.

Notes:

- Eligible Ages are as of March 31st, 2023.
- · Households on welfare and households exempt from municipal resident taxes can be exempted from paying the co-payment by submitting an application to the Health Promotion Division (Kenko-Zukuri-ka) at least one day before the cancer screening.
- · Each cancer screening is available once a fiscal year.
- Those who have not registered in Oizumi Town as of the day of the cancer screening are not eligible.

< Cervical Cancer Screening >

- Eligibles: Women who are 20 years old or older
- Content: Doctor's Consultation, Cytological Examination of Cervix Co-Payment: ¥500

Omicron-targeting COVID-19 Booster Vaccination [オミクロン株対応ワクチン(新型コロナワクチン)予防接種について]

Omicron-targeting COVID-19 vaccine is bivalent vaccines that are against both the conventional and Omicron strains. ■Venue: Yosen Kogyo Oizumi-machi Bunka-Mura [Addr.: 5-24-1 Asahi]

Eligibility: Residents in Oizumi Town who have received at least two doses of the conventional strain vaccine and who are

12 years of age or older. However, at least 3 months must have passed since the last vaccination.

[Those who have unused vaccination coupon]

: Vaccination Coupon will not be sent newly, so please use the unused vaccination coupon.

: In case of loss, please apply for re-issuance at the Health Promotion Division.

Reservation: Please make a reservation according to the procedure mailed to the eligible residents.

[Those who moved to Oizumi Town from other municipality]

- : Vaccination Coupon issued by other municipalities in which you previously resided cannot be used if you have an address in Oizumi Town at the time of reservation or vaccination.
- : Bring the proof of vaccination record, such as vaccine certificate or documents that show your indivisual number together with your ID to the Health Promotion Division, so that your coupon will be issued on the spot.

[Those who do not have unused vaccination coupon]

: Vaccination coupon will be sent out during November. Please make a reservation according to the enclosed procedure.

Interval with other vaccines: Normally, allow at least 13 days before and after (Influenza vaccination can be given on the same day.)
 Regarding conventional COVID-19 vaccination

Those who have completed the initial vaccination (1st & 2nd doses) will be given Omicron-targeting vaccination after the 3rd dose. Besides, conventional COVID-19 vaccination has been offered for the initial vaccination. The supply of the conventional vaccine from the government will end at the end of this year. If you wish to receive the vaccination, making an early reservation by calling the town call center at 20276-55-4661 is recommended.

Emergency support benefit for Price increases in electricity, gas, food, etc. [電力・ガス・食料品等価格高騰緊急支援給付金を支給します]

- Eligible household: Households registered as residents in Oizumi Town as of September 30, 2022, and fits one of the followings. (1)All family members subject to Resident -Tax-Exempt per capita basis in FY2022 ("Resident-Tax-Exempt Households")
- (2) Households whose income decreased from January to December, 2022 and whose income became "equivalent level to resident tax exemption household". ("Households with a sudden change in the finances")
- How to apply:
- ① Since the confirmation form is mailed out from the town, the form must be retured after filling it out.
- (2) For "Households with a sudden change in the finances" and "Resident-Tax-Exempt Households that have a new resident who moved into the household on or after January 2, 2022", those households must apply for this at the Welfare Division.
- Deadline: January 31st (Tue), 2023
- Benefit Amount: 50,000 yen/household
- Benefit Period/Payment Method: Upon receipt of the confirmation form or after the application is accepted, transfer the benefit to the specified bank account.
- ※Households which have tax undeclared residents will not receive a confirmation form from the town. In such cases, please contact the Resident & Other Municipal Taxes Section of the Taxation Division at 20276-63-3111(ext. 574).

Open-Air Burning (noyaki) is Prohibited. [野焼きは禁止されています]

We have received many complaints about open burning, such as burning branches, weeds, food scraps, and other wastes in the field. Open-air burning causes trouble with neighbors for deterioration of the living environment due to moke and odors, and incineration at low temperatures produces toxic substances such as dioxins, which affect the human body and are one of the causes of fires and air pollution.

Please do not burn in the fields as it is prohibited by law. Even in cases where the following exceptions apply, we ask that the utmost consideration be given so as not to interfere with the surrounding living environment.

Exceptions

- When using an incinerator that meets structural standards
- Local customary events (e.g. Dondo-Yaki, etc.)
- Religious ceremonies (e.g. Otakiage at at shrines, etc.)
