■ Detour route & Temporary Bus stop associated with the Festival

Due to the traffic restrictions at the 51st Oizumi Festival, buses will be operated by a detour route.

Therefore, the "Bus Terminal in front of the Nishi-Koizumi Station" and "Senior Citizen Center (*Rojin* Center) Entrance" bus stops will not be available during the detour, so please use the "Beisia Oizumi-mae" or "Matsubara Shindo" bus stops during those times.

Please be careful when using the bus stop during the relevant time




If you use the wide area public bus "Aozora"on July 30th, please note that the route is different from the usual one and some bus stops will be changed.



Requests to protect a good living environment [良好な生活環境を守るためのお願い]

The sound of music, television, people's talking voice, and other household noises may disturb neighbors day and night, so please pay attention to the following.

- Be considerate of the time of the day, especially in the middle of the night or early morning.
- Close the windows so that the sound does not leak outside or out of the room. If you open the window, stop the music.
- Avoid making loud noises when opening and closing doors and windows, and when unloading luggage.
- When listening to TV, Radio, or music, or playing a music instrument, take measures to reduce the volume by properly positioning the speakers and other sound sources, as well as the instrument itself.
- When installing equipment such as water heaters, boilers, or outdoor units of air-conditioners outdoors, take sound insulation measures such as installing sound deadening boxes to the extent that it does not interfere with the operation of the equipment.
- When purchasing home appliances and other products, choose higher silent performance products.
- Refrain from unnecessary idling of cars and motorcycles. Also, do not wear loud mufflers.
- When doing barbecues, etc., take care not to harm the living environment of neighbors with odors, noise, smoke, etc.

Efforts to address rising food costs for school lunches [学校給食の食材費高騰に対応]

Due to the recent price increase and the rise in transportation and other costs associated with soaring oil prices, the cost of food used in school lunches has also risen dramatically. To date, we have taken measures such as devising ingredients and menu items, but there are concerns about the impact on nutritional balance, etc. Therefore, we will utilize the government's Temporary Grant for Regional Development in Response to COVID-19 Infections to increase the current cost of ingredients by approximately 10%.

The town will bear the cost of this increase so that parents will not have to pay more, and will strive to provide school lunches that maintain the same quality and quantity as in the past.

As an effort to reduce the burden on households raising children, the town has been expanding the amount of school lunch fees paid by the town since 2014. Since it will be combined with this EFFORT, the town will pay approximately 36% of the cost of school lunches starting in July.

Please do not forget to report submission required for various allowances

[各種手当の届け出を忘れずに]

Those who receive the child-rearing allowance (*Jido-fuyo Teate*) are required to submit a "Current Status Report (*Genkyo Todoke*)" and those who receive the special child-rearing allowance (*Tokubetsu Jido-Fuyo Teate*) are required to submit an "Income Status Report (*Syotoku Jokyo Todoke*)". If you do not submit the report, you will not receive the child-rearing allowance for November onward, and the special child-rearing allowance for August onward. A notification will be sent to you in late July. Please check the contents and submit it within this period.

Those whose allowance is suspended due to income limitation are also required to submit the report.

Illegal dumping is a crime [不法投棄は犯罪です]

Illegal dumping such as business related trash, large sized trash such as furniture, 4 home appliances, and stones and rocks have been found at household trash disposal sites (stations) in the town frequently. Illegal dumping is a criminal act that cannot be tolerated absolutely. The town provides strict guidance and reports to the police when it is considered malicious or intentional. When you dispose of your trash, please follow the rules described in the Garbage Collection Calendar and cooperate in the proper disposal, reduction, and recycling of trash. Do not dump your trash into trash disposal sites of neighboring cities and towns.

[Business related trash]

You cannot put trash generated at stores, offices, restaurants, factories, and etc. out at local household trash disposal sites at all. Please bring them to specific disposal facilities by yourself or ask specific suppliers to take them.

[4 Home Appliances (Specified Kinds of Home Appliance)]

As for TVs, Air-conditioners, Washers (& Dryers), and Refrigerators (Freezers) which have been specified by the Home Appliance Recycling Act., please contact home appliance stores or etc. for the proper disposal. Treatment of Oil and Collection of Waste edible oil [油の扱いと廃食用油の回収について]

<Please pay attention to the treatment of used oil>

If oil is drained directly into waste water, it may cause river pollution and damage crops, animals, plants, etc.

Therefore, we ask for your cooperation in not polluting the rivers and swamps

in your neighborhood by taking the following precautions.

- Precautions
- Do not dispose of oil in sewers or roadside ditches
- Frequently check for oil leaks from fuel tanks and machinery.
- If oil-water separation tanks are installed in food stores, etc., check regularly to see that they are not overflowing with oil.

<The town collects waste edible oil>

The town collects used household used cooking oil and edible oil past its expiration date as part of its efforts to reduce waste and purify water.

- Location: The Environmental Development Division in Oizumi Town hall
 - (For Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, in front of the entrance of the town hall)
- Hours: 8:30am~5:15pm
- ■Type of oil: Vegetable or animal oils for cooking (salad oil, corn oil, safflower oil, sesame oil, lard, etc.)
- How to dispose: Put the oil in a plastic bottle or other container and bring it to the Environmental Development Division (For Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, pass it to the town official in front of the entrance of the town hall)

[大きな災害が起きたときのごみの出し方]

The town has established the Oizumi Town Disaster Waste Disposal Plan in order to properly dispose of the large amount of disaster waste (debris, trash, human waste, etc.) generated in the event of a major disaster.

This plan establishes a system for waste disposal in the event of a major disaster, which includes a classification of waste separation. For the sake of early recovery and reconstruction, we need to enforce rules and manners such as sorting of garbage even more thoroughly than in normal times.
