Influenza Vaccination for the Elderly [高齢者インフルエンザ予防接種]

The town will provide influenza vaccination for the elderly. Notifications and Preliminary Medical Questionnaire form will be sent to those who are eligible. The available medical facilities of the vaccination and what to bring with you on the day of vaccination are listed in the notice.

- Vaccination Period: October 1st (Sun.), 2023 ~ January 13th (Sat.), 2024
- * During the period, medical facilities may not be available due to holidays, etc., so please check with the medical facilities.
- Vaccination facility: Medical facilities offering vaccinations in Gunma Prefecture and Ashikaga City
- Eligibility: Those who were born on or before December 31st, 1958 and wish to be vaccinated are eligible.
- Number of Inoculations: One time
- What to bring: Pre-medical checkup sheet, health insurance card, elderly beneficiary card
- (People who are 70 to 74 years old and have the card), Other IDs.
- Co-pay: ¥1,000 (Please pay at a medical institution by yourself.)
 - XThere is no co-pay for people in public assistance households.
- Note: Prior appointment with a medical institution is required.
 - If you wish to be vaccinated at a medical institution outside of Gunma prefecture
 - (excluding Ashikaga-city), you must apply to the Health Promotion Division (Kenko-Zukuri-ka).
 - · Please be responsible for filling out the Preliminary Medical Questionnaire (Yoshin-Hyo) in advance.
 - · If you are undergoing treatment or observation, please consult your doctor to see if you can be vaccinated.

Subsidies for children's influenza vaccination costs [子どものインフルエンザ予防接種費用の助成]

- Vaccination period: Vaccination received during the period between October 1st (Sun.), 2023 and January 31st (Wed.), 2024. ■ Subsidy amount: Up to ¥2,000 for the cost of the vaccination
- Eligibility: Persons equivalent to third grade junior high school students and persons equivalent to third grade senior high school students.
- Number of Inoculations: One time
- Deadline of the application: March 29th (Fri.), 2024
- Required documents: •Application/Request for Seeding Subsidy

Registration of Dogs and Rabies Vaccination in Autumn [犬の登録・狂犬病予防注射]

Registration of dogs and rabies vaccinations (complementary injection) will be carried out by the town. By law, the registration of dogs aged 91 days old or more is required once in their life, and the rabies vaccination once a year is also required. If your dog(s) has not received

the vaccination in this fiscal year 2023, please make your dog(s) receive it without fail.

- Date and Time: 9:30 11:30 on October 14th (Sat.)
- Location: North Parking Space of the Town Hall [Addr.: 55-1 Hinode]
- Charge:
 - ¥3,500 per registered dog for the vaccination only.
 - ¥6,500 per dog for the registration and the vaccination.
- Notes:
 - Dogs that are sick, are in pregnancy, or are within 2 weeks after childbirth may not be able to receive the rabies vaccination. In such cases, please consult a veterinary.
 - Animal hospitals belonging to Gunma Veterinary Medical Association are also doing the registration and the vaccination at any time until January every fiscal year. Since charges are different according to hospitals, please check them in advance.
 - Leaving of dogs' droppings is found around the place of the vaccination every year. Since owners have responsibility to treat their droppings, please be sure to bring them back to home.

< Clean up dog's droppings! >

Many people are annoyed by dog's owners who were leaving droppings on riverbeds, sidewalks, rice paddy roads, and etc.

You, the owner, must clean up your dog's droppings when you walk your dog. Dog waste should be buried in your yard or disposed of as "Burnable Trash" in small amounts in plastic bags to prevent the contents from flying around.
