Updated COVID-19 Vaccination for Fall in 2023 [新型コロナワクチン令和5年秋開始接種のお知らせ]

The town started COVID-19 Vaccination (Omicron XBB1.5-Specific) for fall in 2023 vaccination on October 2nd (Mon.). Eligibility:

Registered residents in Oizumi, and aged 6 months or older who have completed their first vaccination and more than 3 months have passed since the previous vaccination. (One time per person during the period.)

- Period of implementation and the vaccnation venue:
 - Group vaccination: October 2nd (Mon.) ~ December 20th (Wed.) at Yosen Kogyo Oizumi-machi Bunka-Mura for age 12 and older
 - Inividual vaccination: Mid October ~ March 31st (Sun.) at Cooperating medical institutions
- What to bring for the vaccination:
 - Pre-medical checkup sheet with vaccination ticket, vaccination certificate (cream color)
 - · ID card (My number card, Driver's license, etc.) · Medication notebook (If you have one)
- Issue of vaccination tickets:

Vaccination tickets will be sent to all those who are eligible for vaccination who are 5 years old or older.

- Others: For those who have not received their first vaccination, this vaccination (Omicron XBB1.5-Specific vaccine)
 - is available. If you wish to be vaccinated, please contact Oizumi-machi Call Center.
