Provides Financial Support for Children of Single-Mother and Single-Father Families to Enter School or to Advance to Higher Education [母子・父子家庭などの入学・進学支度金を支給します]

The town provides financial support for single-mother and single-father families whose children go on to higher education, such as high school, technical college, or vocational school in this fiscal year. Families whose children have entered primary school or advanced to junior high school and have not applied for this program by the end of March, 2023 will be accepted at the same time.

■ Eligible Persons: Those who became a single parent household or are rearing a child who do not have parents, and who meet all of the following conditions.

- You live in the town and are rearing a child who lives with you.
- Your income tax was not levied against your income of CY2021.
- You are not receiving public assistance.

■ Subsidy:

- For elementary school: ¥10,000
- For junior high school: ¥15,000
- For high school: ¥20,000

■ Application Method: Fill out the application form, and apply it with required documents directly to the Children Affairs Division (the counter No.24 on the 3rd floor).

■ Deadline of Application: May 31st. (Wed.) except Saturdays, Sundays, and National Holidays.

Rabies Vaccination in Spring [春の狂犬病予防注射]

Spring Rabies Vaccinations (group shots) for FY2023 will be administered by the town. According to the Rabies Prevention Law, those who own a dog (including small dogs and indoor dogs) that is 91 days old and older are required to register the dog and have

it receive a rabies shot once a year.

■ Registration: Once in a dog's lifetime

■ Frequency of Rabies Vaccination: Once a Year

■ Date, Time & Location: May 11th (Thu.), 12th (Fri.), 13th (Sat.)

■ Fee: ¥3,500 per registered dog for the vaccination only.

¥6,500 per dog for the registration and the vaccination

■ Note: Animal hospitals belonging to Gunma Veterinary Medical Association are also available for the registration and the vaccination.

Please be sure to notify the Environmental Development Division (the 5th counter on the 1st floor in the town hall) of any changes in the registration information such as the death of your dog or a change in the owner.

Notification about Municipal Taxes [税に関するお知らせ]

Municipal taxes are divided into ordinary taxes and earmarked taxes. The ordinary taxes are used for a variety of projects, and the earmarked taxes are used for special purposes.

[Ordinary Taxes]

Resident Tax (Individual):

- Individuals who reside in the town as of Jan. 1st of the relevant year and have income in the previous year are taxed.
- Individuals who have an office, a business establishment, and real estate in the town as of Jan. 1st of the relevant year even though they do not live in the town are also taxed.

Resident Tax (Corporate): Corporations that have an office, a business establishment, a dormitory, and etc. are taxed.

Property Tax: Those who own property in the town as of Jan. 1st of the relevant year are taxed.

Light Vehicle Tax: Those who own light motor vehicles and etc. as of Apr. 1st of the relevant year are taxed.

Tobacco Tax: This tax is included in the price of tobaccos.



[Earmarked Taxes]

City Planning Tax: This tax is used for the city planning projects such as roads, sewers, parks, and so on, and is levied on owners of land and houses located in urbanized areas as of Jan. 1st of the relevant year.

National Health Insurance Tax: This is a tax that people support each other so that people can receive medical treatments without anxiety. Heads of household with an insured persons are taxed.

■ FY2022(Reiwa-4) Oizumi Town Municipal Taxes Payment Due Date

The due date of the Oizumi Town municipal taxes for FY2022 is shown on the "Tax Payment Form" sent to taxpayers as well as shown on the 1st page of "GARAPA English" published monthly. Bank transfer is a convenient way to pay your tax.

■ The Tax Notice of the Light Vehicle Tax will be sent.

The tax notice of the light vehicle tax will be sent around early May to those who own light motor vehicles and etc. as of April 1st. Due Date of the payment: May 31st (Wed.)

Payment Method: You can pay the tax at financial institutions listed on the notice, convenience stores, smartphone apps, and the Tax Collection Division at the 9th counter on the 1st floor in the town hall.

■ Reduction and Exemption System for the Disabled

If light motor vehicles owned by a physically disabled person meet certain conditions, the light vehicle tax will be exempted by application. Since application every year is required, please apply for it by May 31st (Wed.) after receiving the tax notice.

Activities of Community Association (*Jichi-kai*) [自治会の活動を紹介します]

Please cooperate in community activities through activities of community Association as daily community connections.

■ What is a community association (*Jichi-kai*)?

It is a voluntary organization organized by the residents of a certain area, and is the most familiar local organization in our daily lives. The purpose of community association activities is for residents living in the same community to cooperate and collaborate with each other to tackle common problems related to their lives, solve these problems, and create a prosperous and livable community.

■ What kind of activities does the community association do?

There are three types of activities for community associations as follows.

① Creating a livable community

Management of garbage stations, monitoring of security lights, maintenance and management of local Public Hall (*Kominkan*), etc.

② Friendly events

Summer festivals, Senior citizen associations (*Keiro-kai*), etc., to deepen mutual relations among residents

③ Cooperation and collaboration with the town

Activities such as biannual road protection campaigns and circulation and distribution of the town and related agency publications



■ What are the activities of the leader of each association, "*Jichi-kai-cho*"

The main activities are;

- Management and maintenance of community facilities
- Planning and operation of events organized by the community association
- Compiling community opinions and requests, working to resolve issues, and communicating requests to the town

Free Collection of Small Home Appliances and Old Clothes [小型家電と古着・古布の回収]

The town will collect small home appliances and clothes that are no longer used at home for recycling purpose with free of charge. However, Items generated from business activities cannot be collected.

< Small home appliances >

Eligible items: Electronic devices, Music devices, Home appliances, and Products that use power supplies and chargers. (Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law cannot be collected.)

Note: Batteries and cell batteries must be removed in advance.



< Old clothes >

Eligible items: Clothes, bedclothes, Towels and Curtains, etc. (excluding Cotton-filled clothes and rubber or vinyl products)

Note: Please bring items other than hangers or wrapping vinyls.

Wakaba Medical Check-Ups will be carried out by the town for those who are aged between 19 and 39 (Those born between April 2, 1984 and April 1, 2005)

Physical Measurement, Blood Pressure, Urinalysis(Sugar, Protein), Blood Test(Liver Function, Lipid, Blood Sugar), Medical Examination

■ Note:

- Advance application is required.
- The Medical checkup is available once a year.
- Those living in public assistance households and households exempt from municipal taxation are not required to pay the co-payment for medical checkups upon prior application. Please apply to the Health Promotion Division (*Kenko-Zukuri-ka*) at least one day prior to the day of the checkup with your ID card or that of a member of your household.
- Those who do not have an address in Oizumi Town on the day of the checkup are not eligible for the checkup.

■ Note

- Contact your medical institution before receiving vaccinations.
- Children born between April 2, 1995 and April 1, 2007 who could not be vaccinated against Japanese encephalitis due to the withholding of active recommendations will receive the missing dose at the age of less than 20 years old as a special measure.
- Applicable persons will be notified about measles-rubella combination stage 2, Japanese encephalitis stage 2, cervical cancer, and pneumococcal disease in the elderly (only for those aged 65).
- Those who could not be vaccinated within the eligible age group due to long-term illness or other reasons should consult with the Health Promotion Division.
- Inactivated polio vaccine is available for children who have completed the triple combination.
