Be Sure to follow the Rules for Trash Collection [ごみ出しルールの徹底をお願いします]

Trash collection stations are managed with the cooperation of the community members who use the stations.

To keep the station clean at all times, never put out trash after collection or at night, and never mix burnable and non-burnable trash. When you dispose of your trash, please check the trash collection calendar carefully and follow the rules.

We ask for your cooperation so that everyone who uses the sites and the neighborhood can use them comfortably.

Basic Rules

- Separate "Burnable Trash", "Non-Burnable Trash" and "Recyclable Trash".
- Check the trash collection days with the trash collection calendar, and put trash out at the designated trash collection station before 8:30 in the morning on the designated trash collection day.
- Pack burnable trash or non-burnable trash into transparent or translucent trash bags.

- Do NOT mix up non-burnable trash such as metal objects, aluminum/steal cans or glass bottles, etc. with burnable trash.
 - (Safe operation and management of the incineration facility will not be possible.)
- Separate "Other Papers" such as wrapping paper, brochures, etc., and "Other Plastics" marked with a plastic mark, from burnable trash as recyclable trash.
- Do NOT put trash out on days other than the designated trash collection days. Crows and cats may scatter the trash, and there are risks of noise problem, arson, and etc.
- Spray cans and cassette cylinders should be disposed of as "hazardous waste" on the day of recycling without making holes in them after the contents have been used up.
- Always remove batteries when putting out small home appliances.

Do not Forget to Receive Vaccination [予防接種を忘れずに]

For the following vaccinations, if you have not yet been vaccinated, please get vaccinated at your earliest convenience.

《Measles and Rubella Combined 2nd term》

- Eligibility: Persons between 5 and under 7 years old within one year prior to enrollment in school
- Vaccination deadline: March 31st (Mon.), 2025
- Note: Pre-checkup sheet has already been sent out in April.

《Diphtheria Tetanus Combined 2nd term》

- Eligibility: Persons between 11 and under 13 years old
- Vaccination deadline: The day before eligible person's 13th birthday
- Note: Pre-checkup sheet will be sent out the month following the 11th birthday month.


《Japanese Encephalitis 2nd term》

- Eligibility: Persons between 9 and under 13 years old
- Vaccination deadline: The day before eligible person's 13th birthday
- Note: Pre-checkup sheet will be sent out the month following the 9th birthday month.

《Elderly Person Streptococcus Pneumoniae》

- Eligibility: Those who will be age of 65 in FY2024.
- Vaccination deadline: The day before eligible person's 66th birthday
- Note: Pre-checkup sheet will be sent out the month following the 65th birthday month.
 - •Interval of at least 13 days is required if other vaccinations are given before or after the COVID-19 vaccination.



Oizumi-machi Hoka-Ni-Cho funeral hall offers cremation services for dogs, cats, and other pet animals. Please note that cremated remains cannot be taken home. The cremated remains are combined and memorialized at "Partner of Pet Ceremony" in Ota-city.

- Time that you can carry in: 8:30 13:45
- Fee: For residents in Oizumi, Oura and Chiyoda ---- under 10kg = ¥2,200 / 10kg or heavier = ¥3,300 For residents in other municipalities ---- under 10kg = ¥4,400 / 10kg or heavier = ¥6,600
- Holidays: January 1st, 2nd and the days of *Tomobiki*
- Note: Please bring your driver's license card, Zairyu card, or other document that verifies your address.
 - Please bring the small animal to be cremated in a cardboard box or etc.
 - · Do not put any items in that may cause damage to the crematorium.
 - · In some cases, such as large dogs, cremation may not be possible.

(Excluding plastic products without a "Plastic mark" or with stain)



"IZUMIO~" License Plates will be issued [「イズミオ~」ナンバープレートの交付を開始します]

In order to deepen the affection for the town and increase its name recognition, the town will issue a new local license plate featuring its mascot character, "IZUMIO~".

It can be obtained with a new registration, or already registered vehicles can also be exchanged for free. In addition, the existing "plain" and "Samba Gunma-chan" license plates will continue to be available, but the "Samba Gunma-chan" plates will no longer be issued due to limited stock.

 - Preferred number cannot be selected. As in the past, the license plate will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Please check with your insurance company to see if you need to change your compulsory automobile liability insurance due to a license plate number change. (The town hall does not deal with the insurance matter.)
