# Temporary Childcare Services [一時預かり保育を実施しています]

The town provides temporary childcare services for parents who are temporarily unable to care for their infants due to injury, illness, childbirth, weddings, funerals, etc., or when parents wish to relieve the psychological and physical burden of childcare.

- Date: Monday through Friday (Excluding national holidays and year-end and New Year holidays)
- Time: 8:30-17:00 (8:30-16:40 for *Miyoshi Hoikuen*)
- Available Nursery Schools:
