"Gakudo Hoiku (After-School Care Program)" for FY2025 [今和7年度 学童保育児童を募集します]

The town will begin accepting applications for children who wish to join the "Gakudo Hoiku (After-School Care Program)" from April, 2025. If your child is currently enrolled in the "Gakudo Hoiku", you will also need to complete the necessary procedures, so please do not forget to apply. In addition, if you would like to use it only during long holidays or in the middle of the school year, please apply at that time. When applying for "Gakudo Hoiku", please make sure to apply on time. If you miss the application deadline without any special reason, you may not be able to start using "Gakudo Hoiku" from April 1st, 2025. Application form will be available at each "Jidokan (children's house)" from October 23rd (Wed.), 2023.

- Eligible Children: Elementary school children in the town (as of April 1st, 2025) whose parents and other guardians are always away from home for work or other reasons are eligible.

Child Allowance system will change from October 2024 (Payment in December)



Changes:

- 1) Elimination of income limits
- 2) Expansion of eligible children (from junior high school age) to high school age
- 3) Increased payments for third and subsequent children
- 4) Expansion of the number of children counted (from high school age) to college age
- 5) Number of payments changed from three times a year to six times a year (April/June/August/October/December/February)
- Persons who need to apply:
- · Raising a child of junior high school age or younger but do not receive child allowance because of the exceeded income limit.
- Having a child in high school age and are not currently receiving child allowance.
- · Child allowance recipients who supervise and care for a total of three or more including college-age children
- Application: Notices are being sent out in August to those with children in high school age and younger. An application form is enclosed for those who need it. If not enclosed, but still need to apply if any of the above apply to you.
- ➤ How to apply --Apply to the Children Affairs Division (Kodomo-ka) in person or by post mail.
- Application Period-- For applications filed by March 31, 2025, payment is retroactive to October, 2024.

For applications filed on or after April 1, 2025, payment will be made from the month following the application.

Up to 20% back with "PayPay" Promotion [PayPayで最大20%戻ってくるキャンペーン]

In order to support businesses in the town, mainly in the retail and food service industries that are affected by rising prices, a campaign will be implemented to award PayPay points for up to 20% of the amount paid when cashless payments are made with "PayPay" at participating stores.

Reward Points:

Up to 20% of points for purchases made at "PayPay" (2,000 points/time, 6,000 points/period) *with conditions

< Example> If you spend 10,000 yen on a meal and pay with "PayPay", you will receive 2,000 yen worth of "PayPay" points!

■ Eligible Stores:

"PayPay participating stores in Oizumi-machi excluding some stores, such as large-scale stores, gas stations and convenience stores, etc. (Eligible stores will be shown on in-store banners and in the PayPay app during the campaign period.)

■ What is "PayPay"?:

It is one of the cashless payment services using smart phones. When shopping or eating/drinking at a store, you can easily make payment without carrying your wallet by using your smart phone to show a bar code or read a 2D code.
