

Notification to eligible recipients

- FY2025 Supplementary Benefit for Fixed-Amount Tax Reduction-

[令和7年度定額減税補足給付金(不足額給付)の対象者へ通知を発送]

Regarding the fixed-amount tax reduction supplementary benefit (shortfall benefit), we sent a "Notification of Payment" and "Payment Requirement Confirmation Form" on July 31 to those eligible for payment who are known to the town.

■ Notification of Payment:

For those who registered their bank account when receiving the "Fixed Amount Tax Reduction Supplementary Payment (Adjustment Payment)" implemented in fiscal year 2024, or those who have registered a public fund receipt account using their My Number, the payment will be sent automatically (no payment procedures are required).

■ Payment Requirement Confirmation Form:

Sent to those who need to confirm their bank account details for payment of benefits (Please fill in the necessary information and attach the required documents)

- Application Deadline: October 31st (Friday)
- Guidelines:

The town is unable to determine whether people who moved to Oizumi Town after January 2, 2024 are eligible for the subsidy, so they will not be sent a notification. People who fall under the following categories may be eligible for the subsidy for the shortfall, but they must apply for it themselves in order to receive it.

- People whose income tax amount in 2024 was less than their income tax amount in 2023
- People who had an increase in dependent family members in 2024

School Enrollment for Foreign Children [外国籍児童就学について]

The town's Board of Education (Kyoiku linkai) will be accepting applications for enrollment from guardians of foreign children who wish to enroll in the town's elementary schools in April, 2026.

A notification letter will be sent to each eligible guardian. If you wish your child to enter a public elementary school, please be sure to come to the Educational Administration Division (Kyoiku Kanri-ka) within the specified period.

If you are not available within the period, please notify it in advance to the Educational Administration Division (Kyoiku Kanri-ka). XIf your child will not enter the school, please submit the "Admission Declination of Town Elementary School "(Choritsu Shogakko Nyuqaku Jitai Renraku Hyo)" enclosed with the notice to the Education Administration Division (Kyoiku-Kanri-ka) by August 22 (Fri.), 2025.

- Eligible Children to enter the town's elementary schools:
- Children who are registered as residents with their guardians or living in Oizumi with their guardians.
- Guardians and their children wish to enroll in the town's schools
- Application Accepting Date & Time: August 25th (Mon.) ~ September 5th (Fri.), 2025 8:30 ~ 17:15
- Location: Educational Administration Division (Kyoiku Kanri-ka), Counter No.22 on the 3rd floor of the Town Hall

《Measles and Rubella Combined 2nd term》

Pre-vaccination screening form was sent out in April 2025.

- Eligibility: Those born between April 2, 2019 and April 1, 2020.
- Vaccination deadline: March 31st (Tue.), 2026

《Diphtheria Tetanus Combined 2nd term》

Pre-vaccination screening form will be sent out the month following the 11th birthday month.

- Eligibility: Persons between 11 and under 13 years old
- Vaccination deadline: The day before eligible person's 13th birthday

《Japanese Encephalitis 2nd term》

Pre-vaccination screening form will be sent out the month following the 9th birthday month.

- Eligibility: Persons between 9 and under 13 years old
- Vaccination deadline: The day before eligible person's 13th birthday

《Pneumococcal Vaccine for the elderly》

Pre-checkup sheet will be sent out the month following the 65th birthday month.

- Eligibility: Those who are 65 years old
- Vaccination deadline: The day before eligible person's 66th birthday
- ※ Please note that Vaccinations are not compulsory.

- · Old clothes: Clothes, Bedclothes, Towels, Curtains, etc. (Excluding cotton-filled clothes and rubber or vinyl products)
- Plastic products: Products made of 100% plastic can be collected. (Excluding plastic products without a "Plastic mark" or with stain)
