

Partial Subsidies are Available for The Purchase of Energy-efficient Home Appliances [省エネ家電製品の購入費用の一部を補助します]

The town will subsidize the partial cost for purchasing energy-efficient home appliances to alleviate the burden on households due to the rised energy prices and inflation, while also aiming to control greenhouse gas emissions and promote energy-saving lifestyles.

■ Eligibility:

- Residents of the town who have no delinquent town taxes for all members of the household to which the applicant belongs.
- The applicant and all members of the applicant's household have not previously received a grant decision for this subsidy.
- Subsidized Products: TV, air conditioner, refrigerator/freezer
- Requirements for Eligible Products:
- ① Products replaced from existing ones or newly installed products
- 2 Must be unused items 3 Must not be leased items
- 4 Products with a multi-tiered energy efficiency rating of 3.0 stars or higher on the Unified Energy Saving Label
- Eligible Expenses: The following expenses incurred from the date of certification as an eligible project until February 27 (Fri.), 2026.
- Costs incurred for purchasing and installing eligible products (including transportation costs, consumption tax, etc.)
- Costs incurred for removing unwanted products in accordance with the Home Appliance Recycling Law
- Subsidy Amount: Half of the eligible expenses (up to ¥30,000, rounded down to the nearest ¥1,000)
- Application Method: Before purchasing eligible products, submit the required documents directly to the Environmental Improvement Division (*Kankyo Seibi-ka*) between Oct. 1st (Wed.) and Jan. 30th (Fri.), 2026.

Application for Nursery Schools and Certified Child Centers Admission

[保育園・認定こども園の園児を募集します]

Nursery schools (*Hoikuen*) and certified child centers (*Nintei-Kodomoen*) in the town will open the admission application for new children. The application form will be distributed at the Children Affairs Division (*Kodomo-ka*), (the counter No.24 on the 3rd floor of the Town Hall. It will be also available for download from the town's website (https://www.town.oizumi.gunma.jp).

- Eligibility: Children who wish to enter nursery schools (Hoikuen) or certified child center (Nintei-Kodomoen) in April 2026.
 - Children who wish to enroll in the middle of the 2026 school year (May, 2026 ~ March, 2027)
 in order for their parents to return to work after maternity or childcare leave
- Qualifying Children: Children whose guardians reside in the town and are unable to receive care at home for the following reasons.
 - 1) Work (More than 64 hours per month), 2) During pregnancy or after delivery, 3) Long-term illness or injury,
 - 4) Constant nursing care of a sick or disabled relative living with you, 5) Job search, 6) School attendance,
 - 7) Fear of abuse or domestic violence, 8) Other cases recognized by the town as conditions similar to abuse or domestic violence

 - Nursery schools accepting children from 0 years old to preschool age



Temporary Childcare Services [一時預かり保育を実施しています]

The town provides temporary childcare services for parents who are temporarily unable to care for their infants due to injury, illness, childbirth, weddings, funerals, etc., or when parents wish to relieve the psychological and physical burden of childcare.

- Date: Monday through Friday (Excluding national holidays and year-end and New Year holidays)
- Childcare hours: 8:30-17:00 (8:30-16:40 for *Miyoshi Hoikuen*)
