



The town will begin accepting applications for children who wish to join the "Gakudo Hoiku (After-School Care Program)" from April, 2026. If your child is currently enrolled in the "Gakudo Hoiku", you will also need to complete the necessary procedures, so please do not forget to apply. In addition, if you would like to use it only during long holidays or in the middle of the school year, please apply at that time. When applying for "Gakudo Hoiku", please make sure to apply on time. If you miss the application deadline without any special reason, you may not be able to start using "Gakudo Hoiku" from April 1st, 2026.

Application form will be available at each "Jidokan (Children's house)" from October 27th (Mon.), 2025.

Eligible Children:

Elementary school children in the town (as of April 1st, 2026) whose parents and other guardians are always away from home for work or other reasons are eligible.

■ How to Apply:


Fill out the application form and submit it together with required documents directly to a "Jidokan (children's house)" in the school district of the school that your child attend.

How To Care For Dogs & Cats, and The Consultation [犬・猫の飼い方や相談]

Complaints about dog and cat feces, urine, and barking are increasing. Please follow the guidelines below and keep your pets in a way that does not cause trouble for others. Furthermore, the town does not capture or take in cats based on the Animal Welfare and Management Act (Animal Welfare Law).

■ How to care for dogs

- Be sure to register your dog once in its lifetime and administer an annual rabies vaccination.
- Leashing dogs is required by law, so please always keep your dog leashed.
- · When your dog feels the urge to defecate or urinate, lacks exercise, or feels uncomfortable, they may start barking unnecessarily. Take them for walks at appropriate times to help relieve their stress.
- We have received complaints about dog owners failing to clean up after their pets during walks. Please bring bags and always take the waste home with you.
- Unwanted puppies are often abandoned, contributing to the increase in stray dogs. Consider spaying or neutering.

How to care for cats

Unlike dogs, cats are not subject to leash laws. However, under the "Gunma Prefecture Ordinance on the Protection and Management of Animals", indoor housing of pet cats is a recommended practice. Also, when encountering a cat whose owner is unknown, absolutely avoid interacting with it out of pity or by feeding it while leaving it otherwise free.



- · Unwanted kittens are often abandoned, contributing to the increase in stray cats. Consider spaying or neutering.
- Put a collar and ID tag on your pet in case they get lost.
- · Install a toilet at home and begin toilet training.
- · Registration for "My NYANBER Entry System" (Pet Cat registration program) is recommended.


